2008	Hope For Kids Mexico registered as a 503c tax-exempt, non-profit organization
September, 2009	Property purchased in Miguel Aleman; 175 students enrolled
2010	Ground breaking for the new school; "Buy a Brick" campaign
2011	"Raise the Roof" campaign; roof structures erected
2012	"Let's Wrap it Up" campaign; electrical and plumbing started
2013	"Opening Doors" campaign; doors and windows installed
2014	Construction completed and classes scheduled to begin in the new school in August
2016	Begin construction on the new Middle/High School to be completed by August, 2017




